



Traditional Chinese Medicine & Cancer Care *with Veronica Reavis*

Veronica Reavis, Dipl.OM, LAc. of Prairie Jewel Acupuncture will educate participants on how Traditional Chinese Medicine (TCM) – such as acupuncture and herbs – may be used as complementary cancer care.

Common cancer side effects that TCM has been effective in treating include:

- Nausea
- Inflammation of the mucosa in the mouth and esophagus (stomatitis and esophagitis)
- Fatigue
- Low neutrophil (a type of white blood cell) count.

Veronica received her Master of Science in Traditional Oriental Medicine from Pacific College of Oriental Medicine's Chicago Campus in 2015 and a Bachelor of Arts from Grinnell College in 2011. She received her certification in Clean Needle Technique in 2014 and was certified by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine in 2015.
