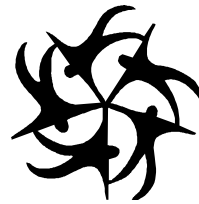

Enhancing Connections Program: A Cancer Education Program for Parents

You have cancer. In addition to questions you have about your health, you may also be wondering about the best way to discuss the diagnosis with your children. The *Enhancing Connections Program* is designed to assist you in helping your 5 to 17-year old with your cancer.

The program includes ways you can:

- Enhance communication with your child in talking about your cancer
- Draw out your child's feelings and concerns about your cancer
- Support your child and decrease stress related to your cancer

This program was created in response to parents telling us about the challenges they experienced in responding to their child during treatment for cancer.

The program is being evaluated as part of a research study, and participating in the program requires participating in the research. This program is being offered at Gilda's Club Quad Cities.

The *Enhancing Connections Program* is offered by trained social workers who are masters prepared mental health professionals with experience working with families at Gilda's Club. The materials used in the program were carefully created by child specialists and nurse clinicians.

The *Enhancing Connections Program* is available at no charge and offers:

- Five 1 to 1 ½ -hour group sessions every two weeks for 8 weeks
- A Parent's Workbook to lead you through carefully sculpted learning activities
